Please book early as time slots fill up quickly. You're welcome to come before your party to see the park facilities

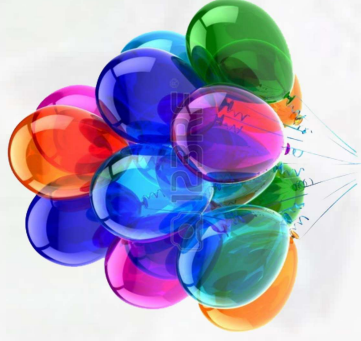

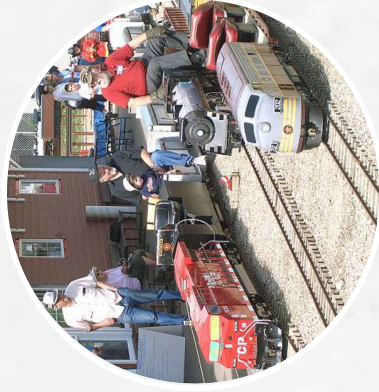

What is Iron Horse Park?

Iron Horse Park is a re-creation of the Canadian Pacific railway across western Canada, run entirely by volunteers.

The journey represents (in miniature) the changing landscape from the prairies, to the Pacific Ocean.

Your 15-20 minute interpretive journey climbs a mountain, crosses trestle bridges and takes you through tunnels, pulled by both steam and diesel locomotives.

Iron Horse Park is operated by the Alberta Model Engineering Society.

October (Victoria Day weekend
to Thanksgiving weekend)*

Bring your family and friends to "ride the rails" for this 1.6 km interpretive journey. You'll get a taste of this fascinating rail history, and learn a bit about our country at the same time.

- ➡ North on Deerfoot Trail to Yankee Valley Blvd.
- ➡ West on Yankee Valley Blvd. to 8 St.
- ➡ North to Railway Gate, and turn right

From north of Airdrie –

- ➡ West on Veterans Blvd. to 8 St.
- ➡ South to Railway Gate, and turn left
